

PROVISIONAL PERMITS

 \odot 18 to 20 years old •Same qualifications • Expires on 21st birthday •Prohibited from carrying in schools •Non-resident rules apply OReciprocity/Recognition/Non-recognition •No corresponding provisional permit? • Must apply for full permit at 21 •All application requirements must be met OCourse requirement waived with proof of permit

PROVISIONAL PERMIT FAQS

- Can a provisional permit holder carry a firearm in schools?
 No. UCA § 53-5-710(2), specifically excludes an under 21 permit holder from carrying a concealed firearm on or about school premises.
- Can a provisional permit holder purchase a handgun from a firearm dealer?
 - No. Per 18 USC § 922(b)(1) a person under 21 may not purchase a handgun from a federal firearm licensee.
- Can I take the concealed permit class and apply for the provisional permit before my 18th birthday?
 - No. A student/applicant must be 18 before taking a concealed carry class and applying for a permit.
- How do I upgrade to a standard permit when I'm 21?
 - O The provisional permit expires on the permit holder's 21st birthday. A complete application, including fingerprints, photo, and fees must be submitted for a standard permit. The only exception is the class requirement which may be satisfied by including a copy of the provisional permit.
