NOTICE OF IMPENDING BOUNDARY ACTION
Creation of the Orderville Reinvestment Agency

Please take notice of the creation of the *Orderville Reinvestment Agency* (the "Agency") under Utah Code Ann. § 17C-1-201.5. The Agency was created by Ordinance No. 2019-05-01. Adopted on the 1st day of May, 2019, by the Orderville Town Council, Orderville, Utah.

Pursuant to Utah Code Ann. § 17C-1-201.5(2)(b), and Ordinance No. 2019-05-01, the boundaries of the Agency are, and shall always be, coterminous with the boundaries of Orderville Town.

The Agency and all of its officers and employees will be governed by Bylaws as adopted and amended from time to time by the governing body of the Agency. The Bylaws will be available for public review upon reasonable request.

As required by Utah Code Ann. § 67-1a-6.5(3)(e)(i), we certify that Orderville Town has met all of the requirements for creation of the Agency. Accordingly, we request that you issue a certificate of creation for the Agency under Utah Code Ann. §§ 17C-1-201.5(2)(a)(ii) and 67-1a-6.5(2).

ORDERVILLE TOWN ORDINANCE NO. 2019-05-01

AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE ORDERVILLE TOWN COMMUNITY REINVESTMENT AGENCY TO BE KNOWN AS THE "ORDERVILLE REINVESTMENT AGENCY."

WHEREAS the Town Council of Orderville Town, Utah, (the "Council" and the "Town", respectively) has determined that it is in the best interests of the Town to undertake community reinvestment areas within the Town as may become necessary or desirable;

WHEREAS the Council intends that community reinvestment projects undertaken within the Town be carried out in accordance with the provisions of Title 17C of the Utah Code, the "Limited Purpose Local Government Entities-Community Development and Renewal Agencies Act" as amended (the "Act"); and

WHEREAS Section 17C-1-201.5(1) of the Act authorizes the legislative body of a community to create a community redevelopment agency for the purposes of undertaking or promoting community reinvestment within the geographic boundaries of the agency, which shall be coterminous with the boundaries of the community creating the agency, or as otherwise provided by the Act.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE TOWN LEGISLATIVE BODY OF ORDERVILLE TOWN, STATE OF UTAH ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 17C-1-201.5(1) of the Act, the Council creates a community reinvestment agency (the "Agency"), contingent upon the issuance by the Utah Lieutenant Governor of a certificate of creation under Section 67-1a-6.5 of the Utah Code.

Section 2. The official name of the Agency is the "Orderville Reinvestment Agency."

Section 3. The geographic boundaries of the Agency are and will be coterminous with the geographic boundaries of the Town.

Section 4. Upon creation, the Agency will be vested with all the powers set forth in the Act and as otherwise provided by law.

Section 5. The governing body of the Agency will be a Board consisting of members appointed by the Council and may be composed of members of the Council.

Section 6. Within ten days of the adoption of this Ordinance, the Town Clerk will cause to be prepared and filed with the Utah Lieutenant Governor a notice of impending boundary action (the "Notice") as required by Section 17C-1-201.5(2)(a) of the Act. The Notice must comply with the requirements of Utah Code Ann. § 67-1a-6.5(3). The appropriate officials of the Town and Kane County are authorized and directed to sign and seal the Notice upon its proper preparation.

Section 7. Upon the issuance by the Utah Lieutenant Governor of a certificate of creation under Utah Code Ann. § 67-1a-6.5, the Agency will be created and incorporated. Upon the Lieutenant Governor's issuance of a certificate of creation, the Kane County Clerk will submit or cause to be submitted to the Kane County Recorder the original Notice, the original certificate of creation, and a certified copy of this Ordinance.

Section 8. This ordinance shall take effect May 7, 2019. The Clerk is Ordered to keep of copy of this ordinance on file and to publish this ordinance in accordance with Utah State Code §10-3-711.
