
Pursuant to Utah Code Annotated 67-1A-6.5(3), I, Roger Fridal,  
Mayor of Tremonton City, hereby provide notice to the Office of the Lieutenant Governor of the  
State of Utah, for the purpose of receiving a Certificate of Dissolution from the Lieutenant Governor,  
of the dissolution of Tremonton City Redevelopment Agency #3.

I hereby certify that, to the best of my knowledge and ability, all the requirements associated with the  
dissolution of Tremonton City Redevelopment Agency #3 have been met, and that additional  
requirements that must occur following Tremonton City's receipt of the Certificate of Dissolution  
shall be met. I also certify that on August 20, 2019, the Tremonton City Council adopted an  
Ordinance authorizing the dissolution of Tremonton City Redevelopment Agency #3, and that said  
Redevelopment Agency has no outstanding bonded indebtedness, other unpaid loans, indebtedness,  
or advances, and no legally binding contractual obligations with a person other than the community.


As the impending Boundary Change is not an incorporation or creation of a local entity, a letter from

**ORDINANCE NO. 19-07**

**AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE DISSOLUTION OF THE TREMONTON CITY  
REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY #3**

**WHEREAS**, the Tremonton City Redevelopment Agency #3 (hereinafter “RDA #3”) was created in large part to adopt the Freeway Interchange Project Area Neighborhood Development Plan; the Tenth North Economic Development Plan, and the West Liberty Foods Economic Development Area; and

**WHEREAS**, in the 2019 Utah Legislative Session the Legislature adopted Senate Bill 28 and Senate Bill 29, which is codified in UCA 67-1a-15 which requires all Local Governmental Entities, Limited Purpose Entities, and Redevelopment Agencies to register with the Lt. Governor's Office; and

**WHEREAS**, as a part of the providing the documentation to associated with the creation of the City has evaluated the ongoing need to have on record RDA #3; and

**WHEREAS**, the Freeway Interchange Project Area Neighborhood Development Plan; the Tenth North Economic Development Plan, and the West Liberty Foods Economic Development Area involved agreements with others including but not limited to Malt-O-Meal, Millard Refrigeration, and West Liberty Foods; and

**WHEREAS**, the purposes of the Freeway Interchange Project Area Neighborhood Development Plan; the Tenth North Economic Development Plan, and the West Liberty Foods Economic Development Area, including all agreements with Malt-O-Meal, Millard Refrigeration, West Liberty Foods, and others have been fulfilled; and

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with Utah Code Annotated (hereinafter “UCA”) 17C-1-701.5(1)(b), RDA #3 has no outstanding bonded indebtedness, other unpaid loans, indebtedness, or advances, and no legally binding contractual obligations with a person other than the community; and

**WHEREAS**, RDA #3 has no connection or relation, nor has ever had a connection or relation, to Tremont Center, LLC, which currently has a tax increment agreement in place with the Tremonton City Redevelopment Agency; and

**WHEREAS**, to provide additional clarity and documentation regarding the history of RDA #3, City staff prepared a summary of RDA #3, which is attached hereto as Exhibit “A”; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to UCA 17C-1-701.5, the Tremonton City Council concluded there is no additional need for RDA #3 and now desires to dissolve the same; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to UCA 17C-1-701.5(2)(a)(i), within ten (10) days of the adoption of this Ordinance, the Tremonton City Recorder is required to give Notice, in compliance with UCA

67-1A-6.5(3), to the Lieutenant Governor regarding the dissolution of RDA #3; and

**WHEREAS**, the Notice of RDA #3's dissolution, in compliance with UCA 67-1A-6.5(3), is attached and incorporated hereto as Exhibit "B"; and

**WHEREAS**, it is anticipated that following its receipt of Notice of RDA #3's dissolution, the Lieutenant Governor, pursuant to UCA 17C-1-701.5, shall provide Tremonton City with a Certificate of Dissolution, which Certificate of Dissolution, upon its receipt, shall be attached hereto as Exhibit "C"; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to UCA 17C-1-701.5(2)(a)(ii), following receipt of the Certificate of Dissolution from the Lieutenant Governor, the Tremonton City Recorder is required to provide the Box Elder County Recorder with the Original Notice of an Impending Boundary Action (See Exhibit "B"), the original certificate of dissolution, and a certified copy of this Ordinance; and

**WHEREAS**, in addition to providing the Box Elder County Recorder with the aforementioned documents, pursuant to UCA 17C-1-701.5(2)(c), within ten (10) days of the receipt of the Certificate of Dissolution from the Lieutenant Governor, Tremonton City is required to provide a copy of the Certificate of Dissolution to the State Board of Education and each taxing entity; and

**WHEREAS**, also within ten (10) days of Tremonton City's receipt of the Certificate of Dissolution from the Lieutenant Governor, the Tremonton City Council is required to publish a notice of dissolution in a newspaper of general circulation within Box Elder County.


**NOW, THEREFORE**, pursuant to UCA 17C-1-701.5, the Tremonton City Council hereby adopts this Ordinance approving the dissolution of the Tremonton City Redevelopment Agency #3. Stewardship for expending the moderate-income housing funds generated by the West Liberty Foods EDA and compliance with expending said funds shall be the responsibility of the Tremonton City Redevelopment Agency.

Additionally, be it ordained that, pursuant to 17C-1-701.5, the City Council directs the City Recorder within ten (10) days after the passage of this Ordinance to give notice to the Lieutenant Governor regarding the dissolution of RDA #3. The City Council also directs the City Recorder to, within ten (10) days of receipt of the Certificate of Dissolution, provide the Box Elder County Recorder with Original Notice of an Impending Boundary Action (See Exhibit "B"), the original certificate of dissolution, and a certified copy of this Ordinance.


In addition to the aforementioned, the City Council directs the City Recorder to, within ten (10) days of the City's receipt of the Certificate of Dissolution, to provide a copy of the Certificate of Dissolution to the State Board of Education and each taxing entity as well as cause of Notice of dissolution in a newspaper of general circulation within Box Elder County.
