Lieutenant Governor Cox:

Wasatch Mental Health Services Special Service District (hereinafter "Wasatch") is special service district organized in the State of Utah on or about March 18, 2003 and is governed by Special Service District Act (Utah Code § 17D-1-101 et seq.). Pursuant to Utah Code §17D-1-106(1)(a)(i), a special service district is governed by Utah Code §17B-1-105 regarding the name change of a special service district. Section 105 requires the following in order for special service district to change its name:

- 1. Hold a public hearing on the proposed name change;
- 2. Adopt a resolution approving the name change;
- 3. File with the lieutenant governor's office a notice of impending name change in accordance with Utah Code § 67-1a-6.7(3).

Attached to this notice is the agenda from Wasatch's recent board meeting evidencing a public hearing was held to consider this matter, as well as the fully executed resolution approving the name change. Further, in accordance with § 67-1a-6.7(3), the following is hereby provided: The current name of Wasatch, as note above, is Wasatch Mental Health Services Special Service District. Wasatch intends to change its name to Wasatch Behavioral Health Special Service District. Wasatch is located in Utah County, and also provided contracted behavioral health services in Wasatch County.

I, Benjamin C. Van Noy, with authority and by and on behalf of Wasatch Mental Health Services Special Service District governing authority and by power of attorney, do hereby certify and verify that all requirements applicable to the name change have been met.

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE NAME CHANGE OF WASATCH MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES SPECIAL SERVICE DISTRCIT TO WASATCH BEAHVIORAL HEALTH SPECIAL SERVICE DISTRICT

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of the Utah Special Service District Act, Utah Code Annotated, Section 17D-1-106(1)(a)(i), a special service district is, to the same extent as if it were a local district, subject to and governed by Utah Code Annotated, Section 17B-1-105; and

WHEREAS, Utah Code Annotated, Section 17B-1-105 sets forth the procedures for a name change of a local district and special service district in the State of Utah; and

WHEREAS, Wasatch Mental Health Services Special Service District is a special service district as set forth in Utah Code Annotated, Section 17D-1-101 et seq.; and

WHEREAS Wasatch Mental Health Services Special Service District desires to change its name to Wasatch Behavioral Health Special Service District;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Utah County, Utah, acting as the Local Mental Health Authority and governing body of Wasatch Mental Health Services Special Service District, hereby accepts and adopts this Resolution changing the name of Wasatch Mental Health Services Special Service District to Wasatch Behavioral Health Special Service District.

In accordance with Utah Code Annotated, Section 17B-1-1-5(4)(d)(i), this name change becomes effective upon the lieutenant governor's issuance of a certificate of name change under Utah Code Annotated, Section 67-1a-6.7.
