CITY OF SANTA CLARA ORDINANCE 2020-04

AN ORDINANCE ADJUSTING THE MUNICIPAL BOUNDARY LINE BETWEEN THE CITY OF ST. GEORGE AND SANTA CLARA CITY.

WHEREAS, the City of Santa Clara has received a request from the City St. George and Dean Terry, property owner, to adjust the common boundary with the City of St. George transferring approximately 1.6 acres from City of Santa Clara along the canal on the south side of Sunset Blvd. across from the intersection with Tuweap Drive. described in Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, the property owner has requested this consideration, due to his donation of the flood plain property to the City of St. George and the canal has recently been relocated slightly to the west & makes since to add this property to City of St. George since the canal has been the boundary line between the two cities; and

WHEREAS, Utah Code Annotated § 10-2-419 allows for municipalities having a common boundary to adjust the boundary by adopting a resolution indicating the intent to adjust the boundary, and to give subsequent notice of the intent, and hold a public hearing as required by law; and

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted such a resolution on Jan. 8, 2020, and held a public hearing on this request on March 11, 2020; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Santa Clara, the City Municipal Boundary is adjusted, pursuant to Utah Code Annotated § 10-2-419 as described on the attached property legal description, Exhibit "A." This Ordinance is effective on the date executed below.







RESOLUTION NO. 2020-01R

A RESOLUTION STATING INTENT OF CITY OF SANTA CLARA TO ADJUST A COMMON BOUNDARY WITH CITY OF ST. GEORGE FOR 1.6 ACRES OWNED BY CITY OF SANTA CLARA, AND REQUEST FOR DISCONNECTION

WHEREAS, the purpose of this Resolution of Intent is to adjust the common boundary with the City St. George by transferring 1.6 acres to the City of St. George in the area along the canal on the south side of Sunset Blvd. across from the intersection with Tuweap Drive.

WHEREAS, Mr. Terry, property owner has donated this flood plain property to the City of St. George and the canal has been relocated slightly to the west, it makes sense to add this property to the City of St. George since the canal has been the boundary line between the two cities, and

WHEREAS, the property is not developable due to being adjacent to the canal and within the flood plain, and

WHEREAS, the City of Santa Clara believes that the current location and status of the property is such that it will meet all tests for disconnection, as required by Utah Code Ann. §10-2-501 et. seq; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the City of Santa Clara to disconnect from Santa Clara and that the City of St. George and City Santa Clara mutually agree to adjust their boundaries to move said 1.6 acres from the City of Santa Clara' municipal boundaries, to the municipal boundaries of St. George City, and

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby resolved by the City Council of the City of Santa Clara, as follows:

- 1. The City of Santa Clara hereby requests that Santa Clara City disconnect certain property described in Exhibit A hereto, a 1.6-acre parcel, on the following grounds:
 - a. That the said property is owned by the Santa Clara in fee;
 - c. The City of Santa Clara requests of the City Council of the City of St. George participate in a boundary adjustment, under Utah Code Ann. §10-2-419.
 - d. That the property, which is an undeveloped raw parcel, is not currently receiving utility service from the Santa Clara City, is not bonded in any material way, and all requirements for disconnection under Utah Code Ann. §10-2-601 et seq. regarding disconnection are evidence.
- 2. The staff of the City of Santa Clara is directed to present this Resolution to the City of St. George for the mutual boundary adjustment, and further directing the staff to proceed with all necessary requirements to have said property disconnected from Santa Clara City and added to City St. George, as may be required by Utah Code Ann. §10-2-419, and/or Utah Code Ann. §10-2-501, et seq.

ORDINANCE NO. <u>2020-04-003</u>

AN ORDINANCE ADJUSTING A COMMON MUNICIPAL BOUNDARY LINE WITH THE CITY OF SANTA CLARA, UTAH

(Applicant Dean Terry)

WHEREAS, the City of St. George has received a request from Dean Terry, property owner, to consider a boundary line adjustment with the City of Santa Clara for property located on both sides of the common municipal boundary fully described in Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein. It is proposed that property would be moved from the City of Santa Clara, and the same property would be added to the City of St. George;

WHEREAS, the property owner has requested this consideration in order to better align the property owner's land boundary with the municipal property boundaries, because the property is bifurcated between the City of St. George and the City of Santa Clara;

WHEREAS, Utah Code Annotated Section 10-2-419 allows for municipalities having a common boundary to adjust the boundary by adopting a resolution declaring its intent to adjust the common boundary line between St. George and Santa Clara, after giving notice and holding a public hearing as required by law; and

WHEREAS, the Council adopted such a resolution on January 9, 2020, and held a public hearing on this request on April 16, 2020.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the St. George City Council, that the municipal boundary between the City of St. George and the City of Santa Clara is adjusted, pursuant to Utah Code Annotated Section 10-2-419, as described on the attached property legal description, Exhibit A. This Ordinance is effective on the date executed below and in accordance with law.
