ORDINANCE NO.	O-2020-0023
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AN ORDINANCE BY THE OREM CITY COUNCIL ANNEXING 1.86 ACRES OF PROPERTY LOCATED GENERALLY AT 1526 SOUTH 1250 WEST AND AMENDING THE OREM GENERAL PLAN MAP BY DESIGNATING THE PROPERTY LDR/SW (LOW DENSITY RESIDENTIAL/ SOUTHWEST), AND AMENDING SECTION 22-5-3(A) AND THE ZONING MAP OF THE CITY OF OREM BY ZONING THE PROPERTY OS5

WHEREAS on June 8, 2020, Mark Steffensen (managing member of Cache Park, LLC) filed a petition for annexation with the City of Orem requesting the City annex 1.86 acres of property located generally at 1526 South 1250 West and amend the Orem General Plan map by designating the property LDR/SW (Low Density Residential/Southwest), and amend Section 22-5-3(A) and the zoning map by zoning the property OS5; and

WHEREAS the City Council accepted the petition on June 8; and

WHEREAS the City Recorder, in consultation with the City Attorney, has determined that the proposed annexation complies with all provisions of state law; and

WHEREAS the 30-day protest period has elapsed and no protests that would affect the proposed annexation have been received; and

WHEREAS a public hearing considering the proposed annexation was held by the Planning Commission on September 16, 2020; and

WHEREAS a public hearing considering the subject application was held by the City Council on September 29, 2020; and

WHEREAS the agendas of the Planning Commission meeting and the City Council meeting at which the subject application was heard were posted at the Orem Public Library, on the Orem City webpage and at the City offices at 56 North State Street; and

WHEREAS the matter having been submitted and the City Council having fully considered the request as it relates to the health, safety, and general welfare of the City; the orderly development of land in the City; the effect upon the surrounding neighborhood; the compliance of the request with all applicable City ordinances and the Orem General Plan, and the special conditions applicable to the request.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OREM, UTAH, as follows:

- 1. The City Council finds this request is in the best interest of the City.
- 2. The City Council hereby approves the annexation of 1.86 acres of property located generally at 1526 South 1250 West and amends the Orem General Plan map by designating the property LDR/SW (Low Density Residential/Southwest), and amends Section 22-5-3(A) and the

zoning map of the City of Orem by zoning the property OS5 as shown in Exhibit "A" which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

- 3. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and publication in a newspaper of general circulation in the City.
- 4. If any part of this ordinance shall be declared invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remainder of this ordinance.
