
I, DEIDRE M. HENDERSON, LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR OF THE STATE

RESOLUTION NO. 20-16

A RESOLUTION CREATING A LOCAL DISTRICT TO PROVIDE FIRE PROTECTION, PARAMEDIC AND EMERGENCY SERVICES.

WHEREAS, Daggett County, Utah (the "County"), is a political subdivision and body politic duly and regularly created, established, organized, and existing under and by virtue of the Constitution and laws of the State of Utah; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Utah Code §17B-1-202(1)(a)(iii) a local district may be created to provide fire protection, paramedic, and emergency services; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Utah Code §17B-1-203(1)(d) the process to create a local district was initiated by Daggett County when they adopted Daggett County Resolution 20-10 on the 9th day of September, 2020. Resolution 20-10 is a resolution proposing the creation of a local district, adopted by the legislative body of Daggett County, whose unincorporated area was entirely included within the boundaries of the proposed local district; and

WHEREAS, Daggett County has an obligation and responsibility to provide the vital services of paramedic, emergency services, and fire protection to the residents and visitors of Daggett County; and

WHEREAS, The Daggett County Board of Commissioners desires to improve the resources available to the emergency management department and increase their ability to provide these vital services to the residents and visitors to Daggett County; and

WHEREAS, The creation of a local district is one option that provides the opportunity to improve the quality of services provided; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Utah Code §17B-1-214(3)(d), an election on the question of whether the local district should be created is not required for the creation of a district after the adoption of a resolution adopted under Subsection 17B-1-203(1)(d) on or after May 5, 2003, that proposes

the creation of a local district to provide fire protection, paramedic, and emergency services, if the proposed local district includes the unincorporated area, whether in whole or in part, of one or more counties; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Utah Code §17B-1-210, public hearings on Resolution 20-10 were held on October 21, 2020 in the County Offices located in Manila, Utah, and on October 22, 2020, in the Conference Hall located in Dutch John, Utah; and

WHEREAS, No adequate protests have been received by the County; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Utah Code §17B-1-213(5)(a), if adequate protests are not filed with respect to a resolution proposing the creation of a local district for which an election is not required under Subsection 17B-1-214(3)(d), a resolution approving the creation of the local district may be adopted by the legislative body of a county whose unincorporated area is included within the proposed local district; and

WHEREAS, The Daggett County Board of Commissioners finds that the creation of a Local District for the purpose of providing fire protection, paramedic, and emergency services is in the best interest of the public health safety and welfare of the residents of Daggett County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF DAGGETT COUNTY, UTAH AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Daggett County Board of Commissioners hereby approves the creation of a local district which shall provide fire protection, paramedic, and emergency services to the unincorporated area of Daggett County.

Section 2. The Daggett County Board of Commissioners state that the boundaries of the local district shall be as shown on the map attached hereto as 'Exhibit A,' and shall include the entire unincorporated area within Daggett County. Included within the proposed boundaries of the District are two separate precinct boundaries, which together make up the whole of the District.

Section 3. The name of the local district shall be "Flaming Gorge Fire & EMS District."

Section 4. The Flaming Gorge Fire & EMS District shall be governed by a 3 member Board of Trustees. The initial board of trustees shall be appointed by the Daggett County board of Commissioners using the procedures established in Utah Code §17B-1-304. There shall be one member appointed to represent each of the two separate precincts, and one member that shall be considered an "at-large" member. Subsequent members of the Board of Trustees shall be elected to 4 year terms, staggered as follows: Board Members representing each of the two precincts shall be up for election at the November, 2022 general election. The "at-large" Board Member shall be up for election at the November 2024 general election.
