ORDINANCE NO. 21-02

ORDINANCE AFFIRMING THE ANNEXATION OF REAL PROPERTY, TO INCLUDE 67.57 ACRES OF PROPERTY THAT COMPRISES TAX PARCEL NUMBERS 05-200-0001 AND 05-200-0004, AND PORTIONS OF TAX PARCEL NUMBERS 05-200-0013 AND 05-200-0018 LOCATED SOUTH OF 1200 SOUTH (ROCKET ROAD), NORTH OF INTERSTATE 15 BETWEEN 100 EAST AND 300 WEST AND AFIRRMING THE ZONING OF SAID REAL PROPERTY

- A. WHEREAS, a majority of the owners of certain real property described in Exhibit "A" desire to annex such real property to Tremonton, Utah, said owners being the owners of at least one-third (1/3) in value of said real property as shown by the last assessment roll; and
- **B.** WHEREAS, the majority of the said owners have caused a petition to be filed with the City Recorder together with an accurate plat of the real property, which was made under the supervision of a licensed surveyor; and
- C. WHEREAS, Tremonton City Council accepted the petition for annexation by adopting Resolution No. 20-07; and within 30 days, the City Recorder reviewed the petition and certified that the petition meets the requirements for annexation as provided by Utah State Law (Subsections 10-2-403(2),(3), and (4)); and
- **D. WHEREAS**, a notice was published once a week for three consecutive weeks, beginning no later than ten days after receipt of the notice of certification, in a newspaper of general circulation in the area proposed for annexation and the unincorporated area within 1/2 mile of the area proposed for annexation as provided by Utah State Law (Subsection 10-2-406); and
- **E. WHEREAS**, within 20 days of receipt of the notice of certification, written notices were mailed to the affected entities as provided by Utah State Law (Subsections 10-2-406(1)(b)); and
- F. WHEREAS, no protests to the annexation petition were filed during the period specified; and
- **G. WHEREAS**, consistent with the noticing requirements of zoning property, the Tremonton City Planning Commission caused to be published within *The Leader* a notice of a public hearing on September 2, 2020, and held a public hearing on September 22, 2020, to listen to public comment regarding the proposed the rezoning; and
- **H. WHEREAS**, after holding a public hearing, the Planning Commission recommends to the City Council that parcel number 05-200-0004 be zoned R1-20; and 05-200-001 be zone R1-8; and the portion of parcel number 05-200-0013 that will be incorporated into Tremonton City be zoned R1-8; and the portion of parcel number 05-200-0018 that will be incorporated into Tremonton City be zoned RM-16; and
 - I. WHEREAS, in addition to the Planning Commission's recommendation City staff, is

recommending that the most southern 5.5 acres of parcel number 05-200-0018 (shown as Parcel "A" on Exhibit "B") and thirty (30) feet on the east side of the Central Canal (shown as cross-hatched on Exhibit "B") that will be incorporated in the Tremonton City be zoned Public Facilities; and

- **J. WHEREAS,** on October 6, 2020, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 20-13 annexing real property, to include 67.57 acres of property that comprises tax parcel numbers 05-200-0001 and 05-200-0004, and portions of tax parcel numbers 05-200-0013 and 05-200-0018 located south of 1200 South (Rocket Road), north of Interstate 15 between 100 East and 300 West and the zoning of said real property; and
- **K. WHEREAS**, according to UCA 10-2-425, Tremonton City had 60 days from adopting Ordinance No. 20-13 to submit this ordinance to the Lt. Governor's office; and
- L. WHEREAS, the submission of Ordinance 20-13 to the Lt. Governor's Office occurred after the 60-day deadline. For this reason, the Lt. Governor's office has requested that the City affirm and resubmit the annexation ordinance annexing real property, to include 67.57 acres of property that comprises tax parcel numbers 05-200-0001 and 05-200-0004, and portions of tax parcel numbers 05-200-0013 and 05-200-0018 located south of 1200 South (Rocket Road), north of Interstate 15 between 100 East and 300 West and the zoning of said real property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED that the City Council of Tremonton, Utah affirms that the real property legally described and depicted, shown in Exhibit "A" is hereby annexed to Tremonton, Utah, and the corporate limits of Tremonton, Utah, are hereby extended accordingly.

FURTHER, BE IT ORDAINED, that the City Council of Tremonton, Utah affirms that the zoning map of Tremonton City is amended to zone the real property legally described in Exhibit "A" as enumerated in Recitals H and I above and as depicted in Exhibit "C."

A certified copy of this Ordinance and an original plat setting forth the property so annexed shall be filed with the County Recorder of Box Elder County, Utah, by the City Recorder.

This Ordinance shall become effective upon adoption and passage by the City Council and the signing of the pre-annexation agreement associated with this annexation. A copy of the Ordinance and plat shall be deposited in the Office of the City Recorder.





