CERTIFICATE OF ANNEXATION

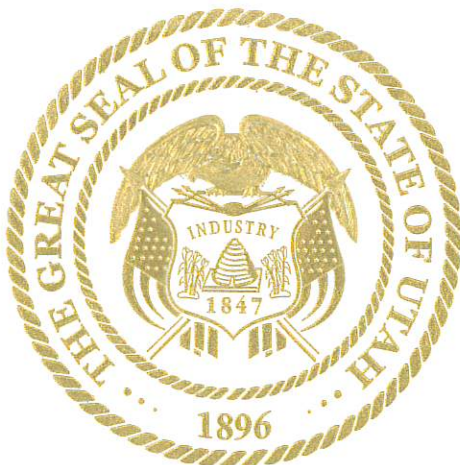

CREATION OF FOUR MILE SPECIAL SERVICE DISTRICT

**A RESOLUTION OF THE HARRISVILLE CITY LEGISLATIVE BODY
CREATING THE "FOUR MILE SPECIAL SERVICE DISTRICT" AS
AUTHORIZED BY STATE LAW; OUTLINING DISTRICT PURPOSES;
OUTLINING INITIAL DISTRICT BOUNDARIES; PROVIDING AN
EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, Harrisville City (hereafter "City") is a municipal corporation, duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Utah;

WHEREAS, *Utah Code Annotated* §17D-1-208 expressly authorizes that the City "may establish a special service district" for the purpose of providing services within that district;

WHEREAS, the governing body approved Resolution 20-16 on September 8, 2020, in accordance with *Utah Code Annotated* §17D-1-203(1)(a) as the "initial resolution" giving the required declaration, a description of the proposed boundaries, a description of the proposed services to be provided, and a name for the special district;

WHEREAS, the city recorder gave notice of the intention of the City to create the district in accordance with *Utah Code Annotated* §17D-1-205 as provided in Exhibit "A" incorporated herein by this reference;

WHEREAS, the governing body held its public hearing to take public comment on the creation of the district at its regular meeting on November 11, 2020;

WHEREAS, no protests or similar petition have been received regarding the creation of this special district;

WHEREAS, the governing body finds and declares, upon its own motion, that public health, convenience, and necessity requires the establishment of a service district to meet the challenges presented by growth and development by providing: water, drainage, flood control, transportation, recreation, street lighting, sewer, and animal shelter and control services to more effectively carry out the purposes of the proposed special service district;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative Body of Harrisville City on its own motion and in accordance with *Utah Code Annotated* §17D-1-208 gives its notice of intention as follows:

1. Declaration, Creation, and Notice. In response to challenges presented by growth and development, the municipality declares that public health, convenience, and necessity require the creation of a special district, in accordance with Title 17D, Chapter 1, Part 2, of the *Utah Code Annotated*, to meet such challenges and for the improvement of the future. This Resolution creates a special service district in accordance with the above referenced state law with boundaries and purposes as provided herein. Notice of the creation of this district was provided as evidenced by Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.

2. Name and Purpose. The special service district created herein shall be known as “Four Mile Special Service District”, unless it is subsequently changed as may be allowed by law. The purpose of the district is for the maintenance of improvements and services within the area of the district.

3. Boundary Description. The legal description and boundary map for the special district was prepared by the City’s engineering consultant, Jones & Associates, and is provided in Exhibit “B” attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.



4. Special District Services. The services of the special district shall include: water, drainage, flood control, transportation, recreation, street lighting, sewer, and animal shelter and control services to more effectively carry out the purposes of the proposed special service district.

5. Statement. Regarding this proposed district, it is hereby stated that taxes may be annually levied upon all taxable property within the service district and that fees and charges may be imposed to pay for all or a part of the services to be provided by the service district. It is further stated that the special service district created herein may exercise all lawful powers and duties granted to such entity as provided under the laws of the State of Utah.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED, that the governing body hereby direct the administration to file this Resolution, and any other required notice or documents, with the lieutenant governor as provided in *Utah Code Annotated* §17D-1-209.

**PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE - FOUR
MILE SPECIAL SERVICE DISTRICT**

In accordance with Utah Code 17D-1-205 notice is hereby given that the Harrisville City Council has adopted a resolution stating its intent to create a special service district constituting the area of the former Ben Lomond Golf Course on Highway 89. The services that the special service district is proposed to provide are water, sewer, drainage, flood control, transportation, recreation, street lighting, and animal shelter and control services. Taxes may be levied annually upon all taxable property within the proposed special service district. Fees or charges may be imposed to pay for some or all of the services that the special service district is proposed to provide. To protest the creation of this district please submit a written protest to the City Recorder on behalf of the Legislative Body in accordance with Utah Code 17D-1-206. A written protest shall be submitted no later than sixty (60) days after the public hearing and explain why the person is protesting. A Public Hearing will be held at Harrisville City located at 363 W. Independence, Harrisville, Utah, before the City Council on November 10, 2020 at 7:00 PM. At the public hearing the City Council will take public comment in favor and opposition to the proposed creation of this special district.
