#### NOTICE OF AN IMPENDING BOUNDARY ACTION

#### To the Lieutenant Governor, State of Utah

Pursuant to the provisions of Utah Code Ann. §17B-1-215 and § 67-1a-6.5, Weber County ("County"), a body politic and political subdivision of the State of Utah, hereby gives notice to the Utah Lieutenant Governor that a petition—for which an election is not required pursuant to Utah Code Ann. § 17B-1-214(3)—has been submitted to the County to create a service district which would be named the Wheeler Basin Service District. The Service District is proposed to provide (1) the operation of parks and recreation facilities or services; (2) the construction and maintenance of rights-of-way, including curb, gutter, sidewalk, streets, roads, water lines, sewer lines, storm drain lines, electricity lines, communications lines, natural gas lines, and street lighting; (3) transportation, including public transit and providing streets and roads; and (4) an energy efficiency upgrade, a renewable energy system, or electric vehicle charging infrastructure. The petition has been certified by the County clerk pursuant to the requirements of Subsections 17B-1-209, 17B-1-203(b), 17B-1-205(1), and 17B-1-208.

The County hereby certifies that all of the legal requirements necessary for the creation of the Wheeler Basin Services District have been completed and respectfully requests the issuance of a Certificate of Creation pursuant to Utah Code Ann. § 67-1a-6.5.

Accompanying this Notice is a copy of the certified petition, a letter from the Utah State Retirement Office pursuant to Section 67-1a-6.5(3)(d), and a copy of an approved final local entity plat prepared and certified by a licensed surveyor and approved by the Weber County Surveyor consistent with Utah Code Ann. §17-23-20.

# REQUEST FOR SERVICE AND PETITION FOR THE CREATION OF A LOCAL DISTRICT TO BE KNOWN AS THE WHEELER BASIN DISTRICT

THE UNDERSIGNED OWNER ("Owner"), of that certain real property in Weber County, Utah, known as the Snowbasin Resort (the "Resort"), pursuant to and in conformance with the applicable provisions of the Limited Purpose Local Government Entities - Local Districts Act, Title 17B, Chapter 1, Utah Code Annotated, 1953 (the "Act"), specifically Section 17B-1-201 through 216 thereof, hereby submits to the Board of County Commissioners (the "Commission"), of Weber County, State of Utah (the "County"), the following:

#### I. REQUEST FOR SERVICE

THIS FORMAL REQUEST for Service ("Request"), is submitted to the Commission for the purpose of requesting that the Commission provide the services defined herein to the Resort. This Request is submitted in connection with and, as required by law, prior to the submittal of a Petition by the Owner for the creation of a local district (the "District"), to serve the existing Resort and phased expansions thereof, as provided for in the Act.

#### A. Ownership; Description of the Property Requested to be Served.

The Owner hereby represents and affirms that it is the Owner of 100% of the private real property, representing 100% of the value, of the real property (the "*Property*"), which the Owner hereby requests to be served by the County, or alternatively to be included within the boundaries of and be served by the District which is proposed to be created as provided below in the event the Commission declines to provide service. The Property, all of which is located in Weber County, Utah, is as follows:

Affects Weber County Parcel No. 20-043-0005 (the "Overall Parcel") Owned by Snowbasin Resort Company 3925 East Snowbasin Road Huntsville, Utah 84317

The land contained within the Overall Parcel as to which the request for service applies and which is to be included within the boundaries of the proposed District in the event the County declines to provide service as requested herein (the "District Property"), is more particularly described in EXHIBIT "A" attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein.

A map showing the boundaries of the District Property requested to be served by the County and proposed to be included within the boundaries of the District, is attached as <u>EXHIBIT</u> "B" hereto and incorporated by reference herein.

#### B. Services proposed to be provided by the County or alternatively, the District.

The four (4) services which the Owner requests be provided by the County to the Resort, which would alternatively be authorized to be provided by the District, are the operation of systems as those terms are defined in Section 202(2) of the Act, to include the following services as listed under Section 202(1)(a) of the Act: (viii) the operation of parks or recreation facilities or services; (x) the construction and maintenance of rights-of-way, including curb, gutter sidewalk, streets, roads, water lines, sewer lines, storm drain lines, electricity lines, communications lines, natural gas lines and street lighting; (xi) transportation, including public transit and providing streets and roads; and (xviii) an energy efficiency upgrade, a renewable energy system, or electric vehicle charging infrastructure.

## II. PETITION FOR THE CREATION OF A LOCAL DISTRICT TO BE KNOWN AS THE WHEELER BASIN DISTRICT

IN THE EVENT the Commission formally determines to decline the Owner's request to provide the services as set forth above, thereupon, in conformance with the requirements of the Act, this instrument shall, upon such determination by the Commission, be effective and be deemed to constitute a Petition for the creation of a local district to be known as the "Wheeler Basin District" (the "Petition"), filed by the undersigned who is the Owner of 100% of the District Property more particularly described above, acting as Petitioner herein, who hereby petitions the Commission for the establishment of a local district as defined and provided for in the Act.

#### A. Incorporation by Reference.

Sections I A. and IB. above are hereby incorporated into and made a part of this Petition by this reference.

#### B. Membership on the Governing Board of Trustees of the District.

It is proposed that the District's governing board of trustees, as initially constituted, shall consist of three (3) members, each of whom shall be qualified in conformance with the requirements of Section 17B-1-302, and appointed in conformance with the requirements of Section 17B-1-304 of the Act.

#### C. Petition Sponsor.

It is respectfully requested that, in conformance with the requirements of the Act, the County Clerk, with the assistance of other County officers, determine in good faith whether this Request and Petition comply with the requirements of Subsections 17B-1-204 through 17B-2-209 of the Act, and upon determination that the Request and Petition are in compliance: (i) that this Request and Petition be certified and delivered to the Commission; (ii) that written notification thereof be mailed or delivered to the Contact Sponsor named above; (iii) that a public hearing be scheduled pursuant to notice; and (iv) that the Commission adopt a resolution indicating whether or not the Commission will provide the services requested herein, in conformance with the requirements of the Act.

It is further requested that in the event the Commission determines that it shall not provide the requested services, that thereupon this instrument be deemed filed and effective as the Petition required to initiate proceedings to create the District in conformance with the Act.





RE: Eligibility for Participation of a Newly Created Entity in the Utah State Retirement Systems

Dear Mr. Quinney:

When a governmental entity is being incorporated or created, Utah law requires the Utah State Retirement Office ("Office") to provide a letter to that entity identifying the potential provisions under Utah Code Title 49, Utah State Retirement and Insurance Benefit Act ("Retirement Act"), with which it shall comply. See Utah Code Ann. § 67-1a-6.5(3)(d). This letter serves as the official notice for Wheeler Basin Service District, a newly created local district created pursuant to Utah Code Ann. §17B-1-201 et seq.

Based upon the information provided, the Office has determined that Wheeler Basin Service District is an "employer" under the Retirement Act as a political subdivision of the state by virtue of its status as a local district. Accordingly, Wheeler Basin District must comply with the participation requirements of the Retirement Act.

This does not mean that Wheeler Basin Service District must provide retirement benefits to its employees. However, at the present time and throughout the future, Wheeler Basin Service District is required by law to participate with URS if and when it offers any type of retirement benefit to its employees.

Wheeler Basin Service District may not currently have employees or may have not yet elected to provide a retirement benefit to its employees. Please be aware, it is not the obligation of the Office to monitor the activities of Wheeler Basin Service District. By law, it is Wheeler Basin Service District's obligation to apply for membership with URS if and when it chooses to provide a retirement benefit to its employees.

Once Wheeler Basin Service District begins participation with URS, its public employees will be covered under either the Tier 1 or Tier 2 public employee retirement systems, as described in the Retirement Act. If Wheeler Basin Service District employs public safety or firefighter service employees, those employees will be covered under the separate Tier 1 or Tier 2 systems for public safety and/or firefighter service employees described in the Retirement Act.

In addition, Participating Employers of URS are required by Utah Code Ann. § 49-11-606 to "cover all employees eligible for service credit under this title." As such, once admitted as a participating employer, Wheeler Basin Service District will be required to cover all eligible employees, pursuant to the eligibility rules found in the Retirement Act.

Please note that the above-referenced laws are those used to determine eligibility for participation and are not the only laws with which a participating employer must comply. Participating employers are required to "inform themselves of their rights and obligations" under Title 49 and should become familiar with all provisions of the Retirement Act. Once Wheeler Basin Service District is admitted into the system, URS provides education about the requirements with which Wheeler Basin Service District must comply as a participating employer.

Additionally, please be aware that should Wheeler Basin Service District fail to participate with URS while offering another retirement benefit to its employees, Wheeler Basin Service District's employees may have a claim against it for service credit under the Retirement Act, which the Office is required to enforce. Under the Retirement Act, such a claim would include all past employer contributions, interest, and in some cases, penalties. See Utah Code Ann. § 49-11-601(3).
