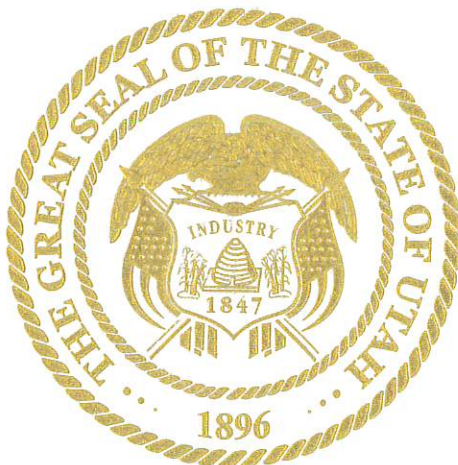

RE: Eligibility for Participation of a Newly Created Entity in the Utah State Retirement Systems

Dear Mr. Nash:

When a governmental entity is being incorporated or created, Utah law requires the Utah State Retirement Office (“Office”) to provide a letter to that entity identifying the potential provisions under Utah Code Title 49, Utah State Retirement and Insurance Benefit Act (“Retirement Act”), with which it shall comply. See Utah Code Ann. § 67-1a-6.5(3)(d). This letter serves as the official notice for Brooklyn Special Service District, a newly created special service district.

Based upon the information provided, the Office has determined that Brooklyn Special Service District is an “employer” under the Retirement Act as a political subdivision of the state by virtue of its status as a special service district. Accordingly, Brooklyn Special Service District must comply with the participation requirements of the Retirement Act.

This does not mean that Brooklyn Special Service District must provide retirement benefits to its employees. However, at the present time and throughout the future, Brooklyn Special Service District is required by law to participate with URS if and when it offers any type of retirement benefit to its employees.

Brooklyn Special Service District may not currently have employees or may have not yet elected to provide a retirement benefit to its employees. Please be aware, it is not the obligation of the Office to monitor the activities of Brooklyn Special Service District. By law, it is Brooklyn Special Service District’s obligation to apply for membership with URS if and when it chooses to provide a retirement benefit to its employees.

Once Brooklyn Special Service District begins participation with URS, its public employees will be covered under either the Tier 1 or Tier 2 public employee retirement systems, as described in the Retirement Act. If Brooklyn Special Service District employs public safety or firefighter service employees, those employees will be covered under the separate Tier 1 or Tier 2 systems for public safety and/or firefighter service employees described in the Retirement Act.

In addition, Participating Employers of URS are required by Utah Code Ann. § 49-11-606 to “cover all employees eligible for service credit under this title.” As such, once admitted as a participating employer, Brooklyn Special Service District will be required to cover all eligible employees, pursuant to the eligibility rules found in the Retirement Act.

Please note that the above-referenced laws are those used to determine eligibility for participation and are not the only laws with which a participating employer must comply. Participating employers are required to “inform themselves of their rights and obligations” under Title 49 and should become familiar with all provisions of the Retirement Act. Once Brooklyn Special Service District is admitted into the system, URS provides education about the requirements with which Brooklyn Special Service District must comply as a participating employer.

Additionally, please be aware that should Brooklyn Special Service District fail to participate with URS while offering another retirement benefit to its employees, Brooklyn Special Service District’s employees may have a claim against it for service credit under the Retirement Act, which the Office is required to enforce. Under the Retirement Act, such a claim would include all past employer contributions, interest, and in some cases, penalties. See Utah Code Ann. § 49-11-601(3).

RESOLUTION # 2024-10-2

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE BROOKLYN SPECIAL SERVICE DISTRICT AND RELATED MATTERS

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Sevier County, Utah on June, 24, 2024, passed a resolution declaring that the public health, convenience, and necessity require the establishment of the Brooklyn Special Service District (the District) to provide the following services: water and garbage collection and disposal, together with all services and functions ancillary thereto and/or necessary and proper to carry out and provide the named services within the proposed District's boundaries, pursuant to the provisions of Article XI, Section 8 of the Utah Constitution and Section 17D-1-101, *et seq.* of the Utah Code (the Act);

WHEREAS, all of the property to be included in the District will be benefited by said District and its provision of the proposed services;

WHEREAS, none of the property to be included in the District is also within the boundaries of any other district presently providing similar services;

WHEREAS, notice of a public hearing was given and a public hearing was held on August 12, 2024, pursuant to the requirements of the Act; and

WHEREAS, the time for any protests to be filed by interested persons has elapsed without an adequate number of protests being filed to forestall the creation of the District, and any protests that have been filed or presented in person at the public hearing have been duly considered and taken into account by the Board of County Commissioners.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Sevier County, Utah as follows:

1. The Brooklyn Special Service District is hereby approved and created within Sevier County, Utah, pursuant to the provisions of the Utah Constitution and the Act.
2. The name of this special service district shall be the Brooklyn Special Service District.
3. The boundaries and service area of the District shall include the Brooklyn Tapline area adjacent to Elsinore as set forth in the exhibit to the June 24, 2024 resolution.
4. The services to be provided by the District shall be the following: water and garbage collection and disposal, together with all services and functions ancillary thereto and/or necessary and proper to carry out and provide the named services. within the proposed District's boundaries

that are more particularly described in EXHIBIT B hereto.

5. The District shall be governed by the Board of County Commissioners, subject to any delegation by the Board of County Commissioners of any right, power, or authority to an administrative control board established by the Board of County Commissioners pursuant to the Act.

6. The Board of County Commissioners directs the County Clerk/Auditor to cause to be prepared and submitted to the Lieutenant Governor of the State of Utah the notice of impending boundary action as required by the Act, in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit A-1, and an approved final local entity plat showing the boundaries of the District.

7. The Board of County Commissioners directs the County Clerk/Auditor to cause to be prepared the Record of Proceedings and Certificate of Compliance with Open Meeting Law in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit B-1 and Exhibit B-2.

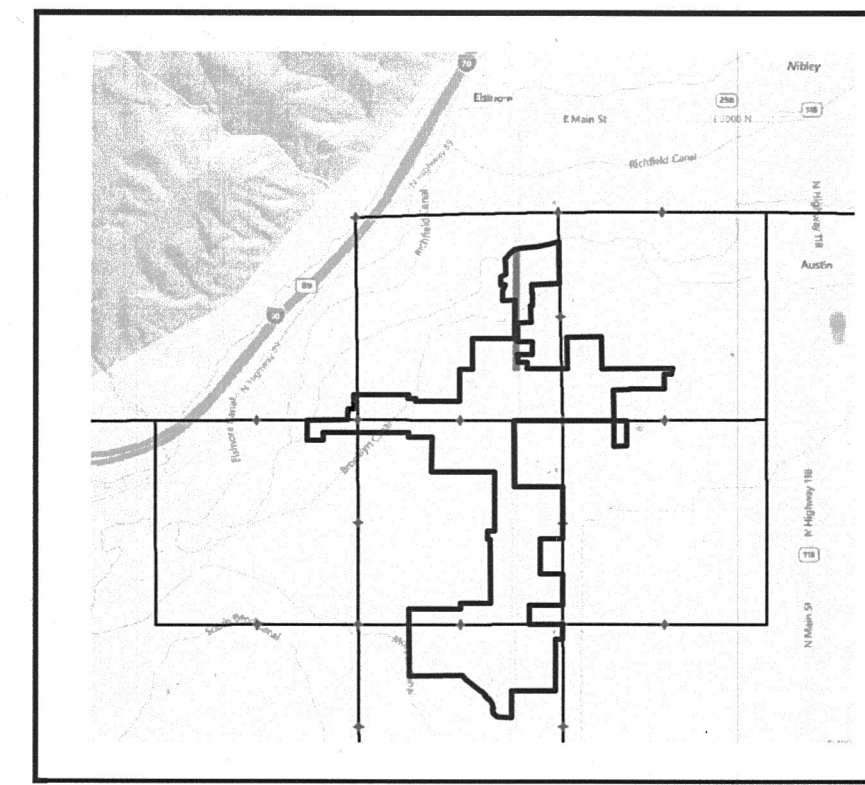
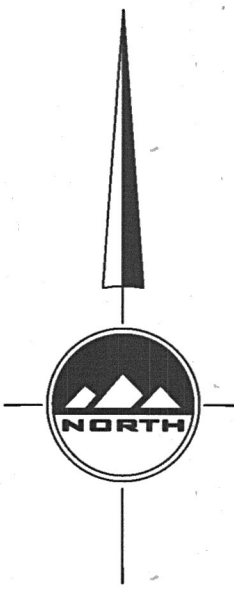
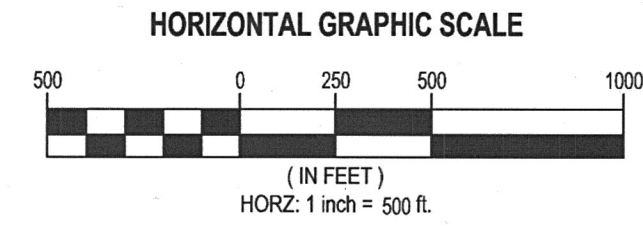
NOTICE OF INTENTION TO ESTABLISH THE BROOKLYN SPECIAL SERVICE DISTRICT
NOTICE is hereby given to all interested persons that on June 24, 2024, the Board of Commissioners of Sevier County adopted a resolution declaring that the public health, convenience, and necessity require the establishment of a special service district, to be known as the Brooklyn Special Service District (the District) to provide the following services: water and garbage collection and disposal, together with all services and functions ancillary thereto and/or necessary and proper to carry out and provide the named services within the District's boundaries, and providing for the holding of a public hearing on the proposed establishment of the District. In the event the District is created, then it is possible that an election may be called and if a majority of qualified electors voting at an election grant approval, then and only then, taxes may be annually levied upon all taxable property within the District. However, at this time the Board of County Commissioners does not intend to call an election. For services provided by the District, such as water services and garbage collection and disposal, fees and charges may be imposed to pay for all or part of the services to be provided by the District. It is the intent of the Board of County Commissioners that the charges for services to be provided by the District will be sufficient to pay for those services. The boundaries and service area of the proposed District are the Brooklyn area

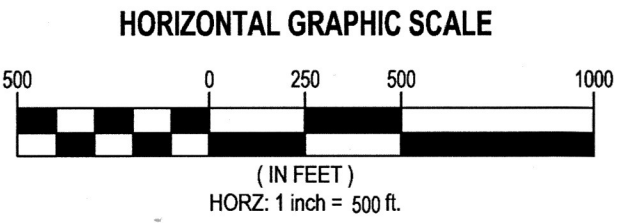

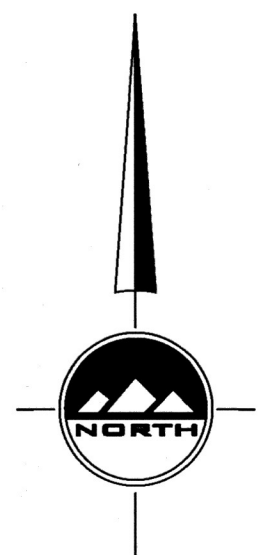
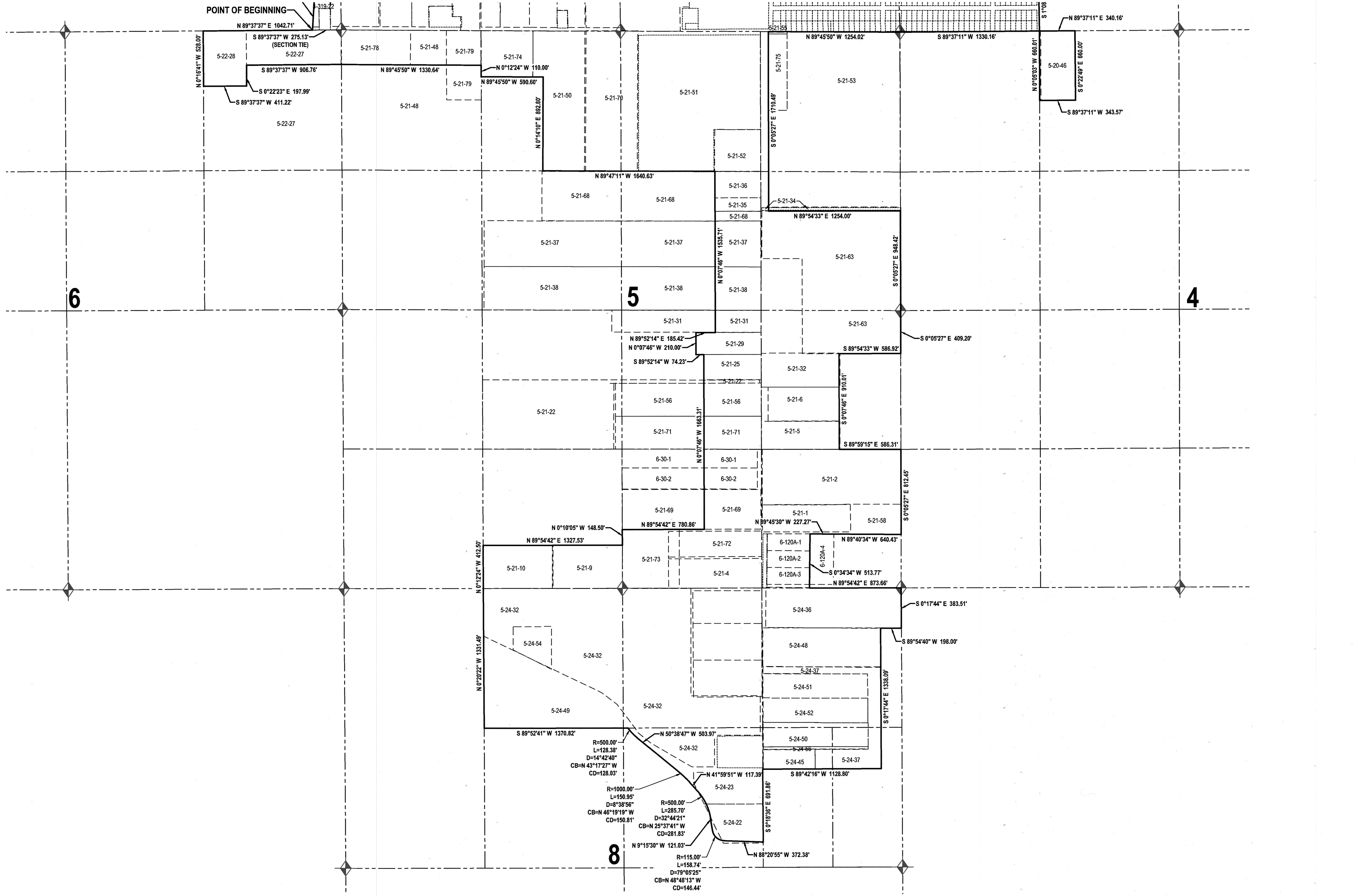
